UTD Women fall at home to Louisiana College 72-66

Richardson, TX--The UTD Lady Comets were up by two at the half but couldn't hold on despite good shooting night.

Freshman Julee Waller scored 23 points for the Comets and added four boards, two assists and two steals in 31 minutes of work, but it just wasn't enough as UTD falls to 0-4 in American Southwest Conference action. Junior Jessica Conrad had a good night as well, scoring 17 points, three assists, and two steals. The LC Wildcats had four players in double-figures, as Patrece Carter was 8-of-16 with 23 points, four rebounds, five assists and one steal.

The Comets shot 59% in the first half compared to 45% by the Lady Cats. But Louisiana College took advantage of a scoring drought by the Comets who shot 41% in the second half of play.

The Comets are still winless in ASC play and fall to 8-7 overall. The team travels to LeTourneau University on January 28 for a road conference matchup.
