UTD Softball blanked for third straight game

Richardson, TX--The Comets were shutout in both games at home against the Texas Wesleyan Rams this afternoon 6-0 and 2-0. UTD falls to 6-12 overall and 2-10 at home.

In game one, TWU pitcher Amanda Sherry allowed six hits in the game and had the offense behind her, scoring six runs on 10 hits. Sherry walked only one batter and struck out five. Second baseman Kamie Lancaster led the way going 3-for-4 scoring once and driving in two runs. UTD amassed six hits but couldn't push any runs across the board, leaving six runs on base. On the defensive side, the Comets committed four errors in the loss. UTD pitcher Chrissie Barnes struck out five and walked two batters.

Texas Wesleyan scored one run in the first inning on a UTD overthrow and the score remained that way until shortstop Shannon Gower hit in the second run. UTD hurler Misty Green kept the Lady Rams off balance and getting several flyouts. Green gave up five hits in seven innings, while TWU pitcher Cynthia Obsivac recorded seven shutout innings and allowing six hits.

The Comets play host to Trinity University Saturday at 1:00 and 3:00 pm in Richardson.
