UTD Soccer wins big over Concordia University

Richardson, TX--There was no stopping the UTD Comets Sunday afternoon against Concordia University-Austin. Both squads were dominating over young CUA sides.

The women came out on a rampage with junior transfer Kristin Demasi scoring on a cross from midfielder Liz Dunham in the 6th minute. That goal would pave the way for two hat tricks added by forward Christina Cox and midfielder Kristin Andrews. Also scoring for UTD was Robyn Martin and Elizabeth Smith. The UTD defense gave up only one shot the entire match, while the Comets let loose 43 shots, 26 shots on goal and scored a total of nine times. Goalkeeper Megan Jones was not tested during the 90-minute stretch. The Comets travel to Hardin-Simmons to face the ASC Conference pick to win the division on Friday in Abilene. Today's win brings the team to 3-2 overall and a perfect 2-0 in the West.

Peter McGrane scored the game-winner in the second minute of play against the Tornadoes on the way to a definitive 9-2 win over CUA. McGrane scored twice and assisted the second goal of the game coming from Steve Sanders. The score going into the half was 6-1 with goals from McGrane, Sanders, David Martin and Estevan Chavarria. Concordia's Memsud Musabasic was given a penalty kick for a foul in the box and found the back of the net. UTD added three more goals in the second half, with two from forward Phillip Pizzoro. With thirty seconds remaining, the Tornadoes had not given up and made a nice run and goal from Keaton Karnei. UTD is looking to repeat its feat from the 2000 season by not losing a single home game. The Comets are 3-0 at home and were a perfect 7-0 last season. The team is now 5-0 overall and off to a 2-0 conference run. UTD travels to Hardin-Simmons this Friday for a conference game.
