ANTON HALES, GRCSW SCIENTIST,  
TO HOLD SEMINAR AT RICE UNIV.

DALLAS-

Professor Anton L. Hales, head of the Geosciences Division of the Graduate Research Center of the Southwest, will hold a seminar March 30 at Rice University. His topic will be "Seismology and Petrogenesis."

Professor Hales came to the United States and GRCSW in 1962 from the Republic of South Africa, where he was born of British parents and received his schooling. He received his B. S. from the University of Cape Town with distinction in physics, applied mathematics and pure mathematics in 1929. The following year, he received his M.S. from the University in applied mathematics, again with distinction. Professor Hales continued his education in England, receiving his B.A. from St. John's College in Cambridge in 1933. In 1936, he won his Ph. D. from the University of Cape Town. Immediately before joining GRCSW, Professor Hales was Carnegie-Price professor of geophysics and director of Bernard Price Institute of Geophysical Research at the University of Witwatersrand in Johannesburg.

A Fellow of the Cambridge Philosophical Society, Professor Hales is also a member of the Council of the Geological Society of South Africa, American Geophysical Union Society of Exploration Geophysicists, and Royal Society of South Africa.

Articles and papers written by Professor Hales have been published widely in scientific and technical journals throughout the British Commonwealth, the United States and Europe.
