UT-Dallas Women loses first match of the season

Richardson, TX--The UTD Women's Soccer team fell to a strong Southwestern University defense 1-0 Friday night at the UTD Soccer Complex. Forward Ginny Callaway scored the Pirates only goal in the 33rd minute. Callaway sailed a shot with the wind that reached just over UTD goalkeeper Megan Jones and was unassisted.

The Comets outshot the Pirates 12 to six, with half of those being shots on goal. SU goalie Andrea Berry notched six saves on the night including a punch over the crossbar that saved a sure goal by UTD. Perhaps the biggest opponent tonight was the wind with gusts of up to 45 mph. UTD tried to use the wind to its advantage in the second half, letting off six shots in the first three minutes. Junior midfielder Serena Griffin led the Comets with three shots, two of them on goal. The team is back home on Sunday at noon with another tough matchup with national power Trinity University. Last year, the Women's team lost in overtime.

On the men's side, UTD won big over East Division LeTourneau 4-0 at the Hardin-Simmons tournament in Abilene. No details were given. The team will take on Maryville College at 2:00 pm Saturday in Abilene.
