UTD takes loss to hot-shooting Trinity University 66-54

Richardson, TX--The Trinity University Tigers shot a sizzling 60% from the field in the first half to lead by 20 points and didn't look back. UTD shot just 33% for the game but point guard Brian Mitchell led both teams in scoring with 20 points.

The Comets started closing the gap early in the second half and came within 12 points of the Tigers, but couldn't quite make up the difference. TU's Jason Morris didn't miss much, shooting 8-for-13 with 18 points and three assists. Trinity outrebounded UT-Dallas 39-30 with 10 more defensive boards than the home team. Despite the loss, UTD's Brian Thomas had a good showing on the offensive end, making seven of 12 shots for 17 points.

With tonight's loss, the Comets fall to 4-2, while Trinity improves to 4-3. UTD is on the road at Southwestern University December 15th.
