SCAS PROFESSOR TO ATTEND LONDON MEETING

Prof. Anton L. Hales, Geosciences division head, will leave Dallas Tuesday to represent SCAS at an International Symposium on Continental Drift, to be held in London, England, March 19-20,

Invited to attend the London meeting by the Royal Society,
Prof. Hales will be accompanied by the University of California's
Prof. John Verhoogen, who is retained as consultant to the SCAS
Geosciences Division, and who will deliver a paper entitled
"Phase Changes and Convection."

With the aim of considering the various types of physical evidence for continental drift in the hope that the discussions will contribute to the study of its detailed mechanism, the Symposium will feature such internationally known geoscientists as Prof. P.M.S. Blackett of the Imperial College in London; Prof. S. K. Runcorn of the University of Newcastle-on-Tyne, and Sir Edward Bullard of the department of Geodesy and Geophysics of the University of Cambridge.
