LES LIAISONS DANGEREUSES is a play by Christopher Hampton adapted from the 1782 novel of the same title by Pierre Choderlos de Laclos. The plot focuses on the Marquise de Merteuil and the Vicomte de Valmont, rivals who use sex as a weapon of humiliation and degradation, all the while enjoying their cruel games. Their targets are the virtuous (and married) Madame de Tourvel and Cécile de Volanges, a young girl who has fallen in love with her music tutor, the Chevalier Danceny. In order to gain their trust, Merteuil and Valmont pretend to help the secret lovers so they can use them later in their own treacherous schemes. This play was made into the Academy Award winning motion picture, DANGEROUS LIAISONS.

BIOGRAPHIES

Brad Baker (Director) is a lecturer in theatre at UT Dallas, and a professor of theatre at Collin College. In 2000, Brad was honored as the United States Professor of the Year. He has directed more than 100 plays and musicals at theatres across the country; including A Clockwork Orange and The Shape of Things at UT Dallas. As an actor, Brad appeared Off-Broadway in Pump Boys and Dinettes and Diamond Studs. He has performed on four national tours; including Carousel, Heaven Can Wait, South Pacific, and Annie. His film work includes Cry-Baby, Broadcast News, Coal Miner's Daughter, Hairspray, The Toy, and Avalon. The credit he most wants to forget is his role as a mutant frog guard in Hell Comes to Frogtown. Brad is a Co-Artistic Director of OurProductions-Dallas Theatre Company.
