Number Two Trinity downs UTD Women

Richardson, TX--The second-ranked team in the nation had no trouble beating the UT-Dallas Comets Sunday 4-0. The Tigers from Trinity University scored all four goals in the first half of play before cooling off in the second.

Forward Lindsay Rowland was the key player for the Tigers letting off 11 total shots, five of which were on goal and scored twice for TU. She scored the game-winner in the eighth minute and then again in the 21st minute. Jenny Tasian notched one goal on six shots and added an assist. Midfielder Erica Adelstein scored once as well.

The Tigers only allowed six shots by the Comet Women. UTD goalkeeper Katie Johnson let up all four goals and made seven saves. Megan Jones added 28 minutes of play in the net and grabbed two saves.

This is the second straight game UTD has been shutout. The Comets start conference play this Saturday at 4:00 against the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor. UTD was picked to finish second in the West Division of the American Southwest Conference.
