Award Honors Berkner, Peavey
For Annual Meeting Efforts

Bound volumes of the publications of the American Astronomical Society were awarded to the Southwest Center for Advanced Studies during the thirteenth national meeting of the Society, held in Dallas May 1-3.

The books were presented at the Awards Banquet held May 3 in the Grand Ballroom of the Statler-Hilton Hotel, by Lewis Larmore, vice president of Douglas Aircraft Company and president of the American Astronomical Society, with particular praise for the efforts of Dr. Lloyd V. Berkner, chairman of the Board of Governors of SCAS, and Roswell C. Peavey, assistant to the president of SCAS, in ^{their} arrangements for the Dallas meeting.

Volumes accepted by Mr. Peavey include the 22-volume "Advances in the Astronautical Sciences" and the 12-volume "Science and Technology Series." Housed in the SCAS Library in the Founders Building, the collection will grow with the annual addition of new bound volumes of Society publications.
