THREE SCIENTISTS FROM GRADUATE RESEARCH CENTER
OF THE SOUTHWEST TO LECTURE AT TEXAS COLLEGE IN TYLER

Scientists from three divisions of the GRCSW's research and academic arm, the Southwest Center for Advanced Studies, will lecture at a summer science institute for elementary school teachers to be held at Texas College, Tyler, Texas, beginning July 6.

Scheduled are: Mrs. Brian A. Tinsley of the SCAS Mathematics and Mathematical Physics division. Mrs. Tinsley will give the morning lectures on July 6; her 3½-hour presentation will be entitled "Astronomy," and will be illustrated by films.

Dr. Brian A. Tinsley of the Atmospheric and Space Sciences division will have the 3½-hour period the afternoon of July 6. Also illustrated by films, Dr. Tinsley's lecture title will be "The Atmosphere of the Earth."

Prof. John W. Graham of the Geosciences division is scheduled for a 3½-hour presentation on July 8. He will discuss "The Oceans," their composition, physical properties, circulation, waves, ocean basins, and sediments.

Sponsored by the National Science Foundation, these summer institutes are designed to provide supplementary training in science and mathematics to teachers from kindergarten through grade 6 to equip them better to carry out science programs in the grade schools. The training is also open to supervisors and principals concerned with instruction in /science. elementary grade
