UTD Softball shutout by undefeated Louisiana College

Richardson, TX--The UTD Comet softball team collected only three hits in two games against conference foe Louisiana College. Pitchers Rose May and Emillee Collins combined for two shutout victories over the Comets to stay in the hunt for an ASC East Division title.

The Wildcats had just eight hits but capitalized on six Comet errors in game one. UTD hurler Chrissie Barnes gave up eight hits and six of the 10 runs scored were earned. Barnes walked three in the loss. Leading the way for LC was right fielder Misty Roark who batted 3-for-3, while scoring once and driving a run in as well. Pitcher Rose May gave up two hits while striking out four in five innings of work. UTD's shortstop Candace Felts and first baseman Misty Green charted the two hits.

In game two, ASC Pitcher of the Week Emillee Collins allowed only one Comet on base with a hit to center field from catcher Christina Sass. Collins struck out six and didn't allow any walks. Louisiana College scored six runs in the third inning on two outs.

Louisiana College is now 14-0 overall and 6-0 in the East Division. UTD falls to 6-8 overall and 4-6 in conference play. The two teams meet up again for a doubleheader starting at 1:00 pm in Richardson.
