CHILDREN'S ART COMPETITION BEGINS FEBRUARY 27 AT GRCSW

The Richardson Civic Arts Society will sponsor a children's art competition and exhibit in the first floor gallery of the Founders Building of the Graduate Research Center of the Southwest, opening Sunday afternoon, February 27, from 2 to 5. The public is invited, and there is no admission charge.

Richardson school students have been given the opportunity to submit entries at the Founders Building, 2400 N. Armstrong Parkway, Richardson, Saturday morning, February 26, between 8 and 10.

Thirty ribbons will be awarded to winning students, competing in four divisions: 1st through 3rd grades, 4th through 6th grades, 7th through 9th grades, and 10th through 12th grades. Five Southern Methodist University art majors, studying with SMU Assistant Professor Barbara Maples, will serve as judges: Geraldine Crow, Rita Mallett, Julie Malous, Gay Massengail, and DeAnn Watson.

The art media is not limited, and the student's work may have been completed at home or at school. The only limitation is one entry per student, Mrs. Donna Adams, Richardson Civic Arts Society, advises, and all entries received will be displayed, space permitting. The Society has requested that all oils, watercolors, sketches, pastels be mounted or framed ready to hang. Pedestals will be provided for sculpture, ceramics, papier mache.

The exhibit will continue through March 20.
